The Bonneville Power Administration (Bonneville) in cooperation with the Bureau of Reclamation prepared a draft environmental assessment (EA) for the proposed Columbia River Basin Tributary Habitat Restoration program. The EA describes the program and why it is needed, discusses the environmental impacts the associated projects would create, and lists the mitigation measures that would lessen those impacts.
