## To: People Interested in the Kootenai River White Sturgeon and Burbot Hatcheries Project (Formerly known as Kootenai Tribe of Idaho Native Fish Aquaculture Program)

**Proposal:** The Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) is proposing to fund the Kootenai Tribe of Idaho to upgrade their existing Kootenai white sturgeon aquaculture facility and construct a new facility to expand their white sturgeon and burbot artificial production programs. The new facility would be located on property owned by the Tribe at the confluence of the Moyie and Kootenai Rivers near Bonners Ferry in Boundary County, Idaho. Current production of Kootenai River white sturgeon at the existing Tribal Hatchery is restricted by capacity limitations and adequate facilities for artificial burbot production do not exist.

<u>**Comment Opportunity</u>:** BPA has prepared a Preliminary Environmental Assessment (EA) to analyze the potential environmental consequences of this proposed action and we would like to hear your views.
