To: Parties interested in the Mid-Columbia Coho Restoration Program - Trinity Acclimation Site

Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) has completed its environmental review of the Trinity coho acclimation site and has decided to fund the construction and operation of the site. This letter briefly describes the action, the environmental review, and whom to contact if you have questions.

Under the proposal, BPA will fund the Confederated Tribes and Bands of the Yakama Nation to construct and operate two ponds and three above-ground tanks for acclimating coho salmon as part of the Mid-Columbia Coho Restoration Program. The site will be located at the Trinity hydroelectric plant in Chelan County, Washington.

To ensure consideration of potential environmental impacts of the acclimation site, BPA prepared a supplement analysis to the 2012 Mid-Columbia Coho Restoration Program Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) (DOE/EIS-0425). As part of the supplement analysis, BPA sent letters in August 2014 to potentially affected landowners; federal, state, and local agencies; tribes; and interest groups that explained the proposal and requested comments. One comment was received. Using the public input and consideration of potential environmental impacts, BPA completed the supplement analysis, confirming that the acclimation site and its potential effects on the environment are consistent with those that had been analyzed under the 2012 EIS, and that a supplemental or new EIS did not need to be prepared.
