Dear Mr. Walk:

This communication is the Bonneville Power Administration's (BPA) final response to your request for agency records made under the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552 (FOIA). Your records request was received on August 22, 2018 and was formally acknowledged on August 29, 2018.

Request

Agency records regarding, "... [BPA's] 'Max Bill Rate' associated with the requisition BPAJP00008463..."

Response

BPA conducted electronic searches for responsive records in the following agency offices:

Supplemental Labor Management Office

Responsive records were gathered. BPA is herein releasing 2 pages of agency records responsive to your request, with no redactions applied.

Discretionary Release

The FOIA generally requires the release of all government records upon request. However, the FOIA permits withholding limited information as described in 5 U.S.C. §§ 552(b)(1-9). BPA believes that the response to your request involves agency records containing pre-decisional and deliberative information, the release of which might harm interests intended to be protected by the 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(5) (Exemption 5) deliberative process privilege. That deliberative process privilege protects records evincing the deliberative or decision-making processes of government agencies from public release.

That said, please be aware that while responding to your FOIA request, and in reviewing the responsive agency records for potential redaction under Exemption 5, BPA has been at all times mindful of Attorney General Holder's Memorandum for Heads of Executive Departments and Agencies Concerning the FOIA, 74 Fed. Reg. 51879 (Oct. 8, 2009) (Holder Memo), directing all Federal agencies to adopt a presumption in favor of disclosure. In accord with the Holder Memo, records protected by Exemption 5's deliberative process privilege may be discretionarily released. BPA has considered and approved the discretionary release of some information in the responsive records set that would otherwise be arguably subject to Exemption 5.

Fee

There are no FOIA fees applicable to the fulfillment of your request for BPA records.

Certification

Pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 1004.7(b)(2), I am the individual responsible for the records release and determinations described above. Your FOIA request BPA-2017-01508-F is now closed with all available agency records provided.

Appeal

The adequacy of the search may be appealed within 90 calendar days from your receipt of this letter pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 1004.8. Appeals should be addressed to:

The written appeal, including the envelope, must clearly indicate that a FOIA appeal is being made. You may also submit your appeal by e-mail to OHA.filings@hq.doe.gov, including the phrase "Freedom of Information Appeal" in the subject line. (The Office of Hearings and Appeals prefers to receive appeals by email.) The appeal must contain all the elements required by 10 C.F.R. § 1004.8, including a copy of the determination letter. Thereafter, judicial review will be available to you in the Federal District Court either (1) in the district where you reside, (2) where you have your principal place of business, (3) where DOE's records are situated, or (4) in the District of Columbia.
