Dear Mr. Prats,

This communication is the final response to your request for Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) records made under the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552 (FOIA). Your request was received on April 14, 2021, with a formal acknowledgement letter sent to you on April 26, 2021.

Request

“...the number of BPA contractors who have notified Supplemental Labor Management Office (SLMO) after February 1, 2021 that their representative staffing agency (employer) will change because of the BPA Supplemental Labor Management Office RATIONALIZED SUPPLIERS process. In other words, number of contractors who must find another representative staffing agency/employer because their current employer is not one of the 8 selected staffing agencies due to the RATIONALIZED SUPPLIERS process. In addition to a total number, provide a summary of the number of contractors that are going to a particular staffing agency due to the RATIONALIZED SUPPLIERS process. For example, due to the SLMO RATIONALIZED SUPPLIERS process, how many contractors s have selected Aerotek as their new employer; Flux as their new employer; ACS as their new employer, CorSource as their new employer; Motus as their new employer; Everest as their new employer; Azad as their new employer; First Tek as their new employer; Triad as their new employer; Salient/CRTG as their new employer; etc.”

Response

BPA conducted records and information searches in the agency’s Supplemental Labor office and found 1 record responsive to your request. BPA is releasing the record with no redactions.

Certification

Pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 1004.7(b)(2), I am the individual responsible for the search and the information described above. Your FOIA request BPA-2021-00586-F is now closed.

Appeal

The adequacy of the search may be appealed within 90 calendar days from your receipt of this letter pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 1004.8. Appeals should be addressed to:

The written appeal, including the envelope, must clearly indicate that a FOIA appeal is being made. You may also submit your appeal by e-mail to OHA.filings@hq.doe.gov, including the phrase "Freedom of Information Appeal" in the subject line. (The Office of Hearings and Appeals prefers to receive appeals by email.) The appeal must contain all the elements required by 10 C.F.R. § 1004.8, including a copy of the determination letter. Thereafter, judicial review will be available to you in the Federal District Court either (1) in the district where you reside, (2) where you have your principal place of business, (3) where DOE's records are situated, or (4) in the District of Columbia.
