June 9, Thursday	Deadline to file "Petitions to Intervene" and "Qualified Persons" forms. If intervener intends to review Confidential Information, "Consent to be Bound" form must be included with intervention.
June 13, Monday	Utility must notify interveners of any objections to Qualified Persons
June 20, Monday	Deadline for objections to Petitions to Intervene due to BPA
June 22, Wednesday	BPA grants or denies Petitions to Intervene, and deadline for Utilities' to submit objections to Qualified Persons
June 24, Friday	Deadline for Utilities' responses to objections to Qualified Persons
June 27, Monday	Data Request period begins (50 days). (Responding Utility has 10 calendar days to respond.)
August 16, Tuesday	Data Request period ends. Last day to submit a Data Request. (Responding Utility has 10 calendar days to respond)
September 20, Tuesday	Deadline for BPA and parties to submit "Issue Lists" on Utilities' Filings
October 12, Wednesday	Deadline to reply to Issue Lists from all Parties on Utilities' Filings
October 19, Wednesday	Clarification workshop (as needed)
October 19, Wednesday	Draft ASC Reports published*
January 19, Thursday	Clarification (if requested)
February 8, Wednesday	Deadline to Request Oral Argument
February 22, Wednesday	Oral Argument (if requested)
October 26, Wednesday	Deadline for comment on Draft Reports
October 28, Friday	Final ASC Reports published*
