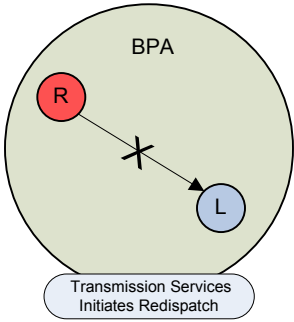

BPA – NT (Firm or Secondary)

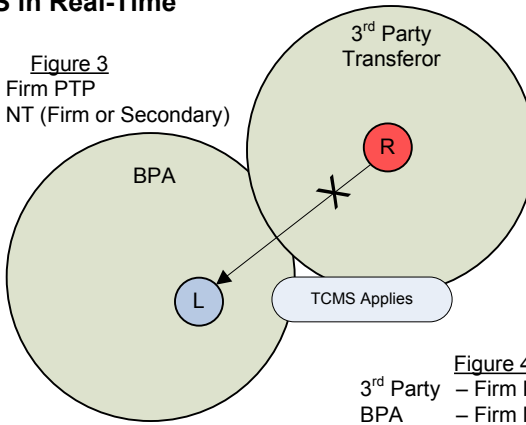

BPA – Secondary NT

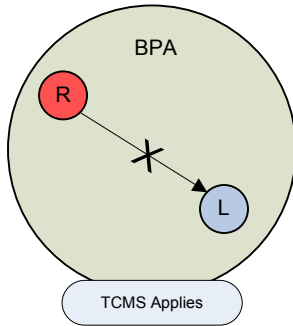
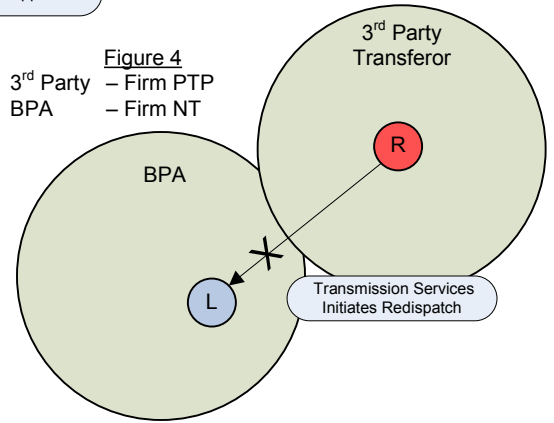

Transferor – NT (Firm or Secondary)

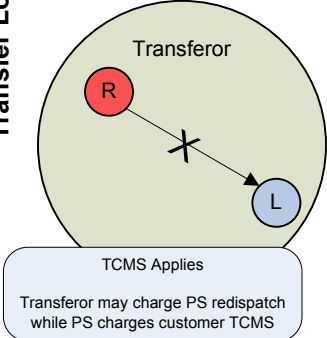

Transferor – NT (Firm or Secondary)

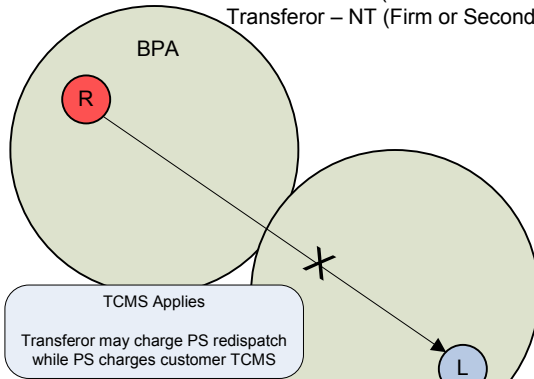

Transferor – NT (Firm or Secondary)

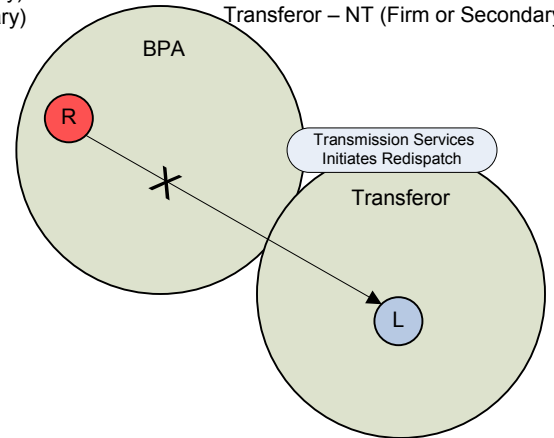

Transferor – Secondary NT

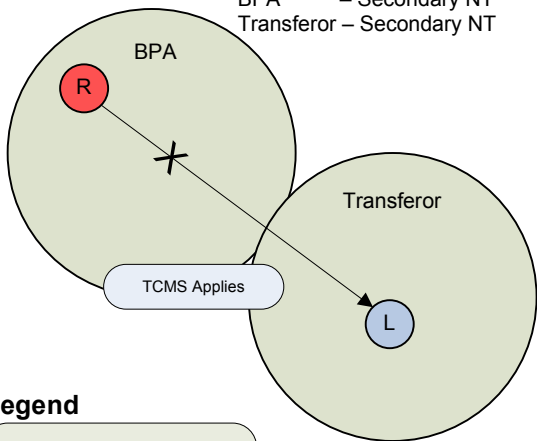

Transferor – NT (Firm or Secondary)

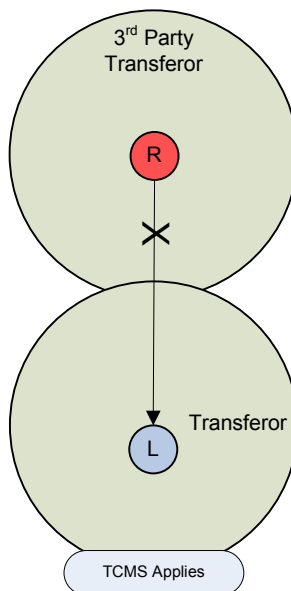
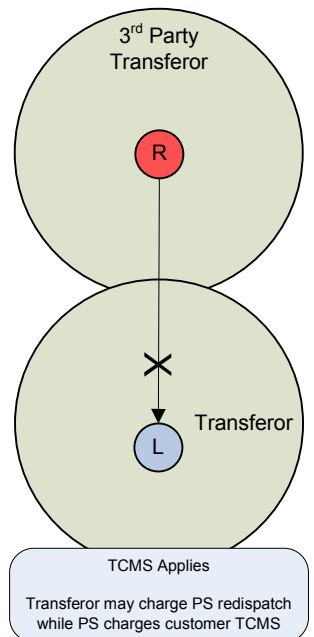
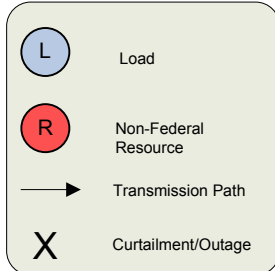
