

FY09 TEAP Equipment

The Tools and Equipment & Acquisition Program (TEAP) Fleet Equipment project is a replacement project for the purchase and replacement of the large tools and equipment that have reached or surpassed their useful life. The equipment in this proposal is located throughout the BPA system and includes cranes, manlifts of various sizes, digger Derrick trucks, pole trucks and trailers, crawler tractors, backhoes, snowcats & trailers, substation maintenance and construction route vans, small boom trucks and manlifts, along with other specialized equipment for stringing conductors and overall maintenance of the transmission system.

This project is meant to mitigate the financial, safety, and reliability risks associated with using and attempting to maintain fatigued and obsolete equipment.

The total FY09 capital expenditures are estimated to be \$9.3 million. All procurement actions for the FY09 TEAP program are anticipated to be completed by May 31, 2009.
