Efficiency Exchange 2024 registration is open

Registration for Efficiency Exchange 2024 at the Coeur d'Alene Conference Center in Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, May 14-15, is now open. Early bird pricing for in-person attendees representing utilities, government, or nonprofits is \$350. Beginning April 12, registration will increase to \$450.

2024 Federal Poverty Guidelines

The <u>Federal Poverty Guidelines</u> have been updated for 2024. These determine financial eligibility for several federal programs, and BPA relies on them as a benchmark for its Low-Income Energy Efficiency Program. Households can qualify for BPA's Low Income Energy Efficiency program if their gross income falls within 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines or is eligible using an approved statewide or tribal guideline. BPA has updated its optional Income Verification Form located in the <u>IM Document Library</u>.
