2024 Federal Poverty Guidelines

The <u>Federal Poverty Guidelines</u> have been updated for 2024. These determine financial eligibility for several federal programs, and BPA relies on them as a benchmark for its Low-Income Energy Efficiency Program. Households can qualify for BPA's Low Income Energy Efficiency program if their gross income falls within 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines or is eligible using an approved statewide or tribal guideline. BPA has updated its optional <u>Income Verification Form</u> located in the <u>IM Document Library</u>.
