BEETS site savings errors have been corrected

In February 2023, the BPA Energy Efficiency Tracking System (BEETS) began incorrectly calculating total site savings for unit energy savings (UES) measures reported with a quantity greater than one. Total site savings for UES applications displayed in BEETS and the Activity Report are perunit-based and were therefore understated. This had no impact on total busbar savings or earned performance payment. As of March 30, 2024, the issue has been resolved and new or updated applications will display correct total site savings.

In addition, UES measures submitted with a "Calculated" measure type have been displaying a total site savings of zero since BEETS was first launched. This issue has been corrected as of May 25, 2024. However, calculated measures reported before that date will continue to display a total site savings of zero.
